SAFETY: How to stay safe

- Do not walk around with hot substances.
- Wear protective clothing & equipment.
- Use proper equipment.

GLOSSARY: Words you need to understand

Danger Exposure to harm or injury.

Reassure Free from fear or terror.

First Aid Officer Person who will treat injuries in the workplace.

How to treat a burn

Danger

1. Remove person from injury zone & protect self.

Cool

2. Place burnt part of body under cold running water for 20 minutes.
3. Remove burnt clothing unless stuck to skin.
4. Remove jewellery, watches, rings & any tight items from the burnt area.
5. For chemical burns, remove shoes.



Cover

6. Place a non stick dressing or material over cooled burn.
7. You can use: cling wrap, pillow case, towel, calico.



Reassure

Talk to and try and calm the injured person.



Get Help

8. Dial 000 and ask for ambulance.
9. Notify supervisor & first aid officer.



DO NOT

Do Not



- Remove stuck clothing.
- Put ice on burn.
- Break blisters.
- Apply ointments, butter, lotions.
- Apply cotton wool or fluffy towels.
