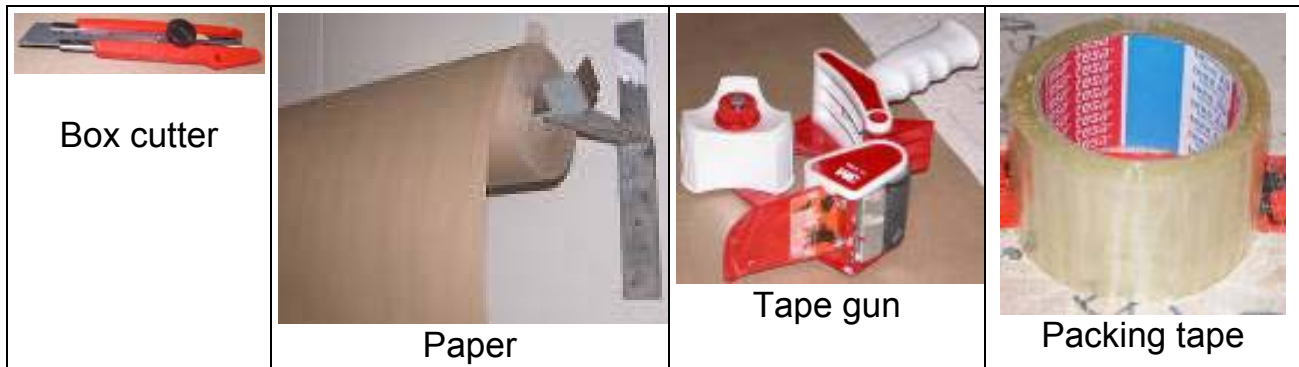


Packaging: Wrap an art work in paper.

EQUIPMENT: What you will need



SAFETY: How to stay safe

Never lift anything heavy without asking for some help.
Put knives and sharps out of reach of children. Do not leave them lying around.
Shoes and boots must cover your feet when you work near heavy things.

PACKAGING: Wrap art work in paper

Wrap artwork

You have an artwork that you need to pack:

- pick it up.
- place the artwork on the packing table.



Cut paper

Cut a length of paper large enough for the artwork.



Put art on paper

Place the artwork on the paper:

- cut the paper off the roll.
- the paper needs to be big enough to wrap or roll all around the art work.



Roll in paper

Roll or wrap the artwork in the paper:

- make sure the artwork is all wrapped in paper.



Tape paper

Tape the paper closed like this.



More tape

Add more tape along the join to keep the paper closed.



Finish

When you have finished:

- the artwork is all covered in paper.
- the paper is all taped together where it joins: ends, top, bottom, sides.
