





Packaging: Wrap an art work in cardboard.

EQUIPMENT: What you will need

SAFETY: How to stay safe

Never lift anything heavy without asking for some help.
Put knives and sharps out of reach of children. Do not leave them lying around.
Shoes and boots must cover your feet when you work near heavy things.

Packaging: Wrap art work in cardboard

Corrugated cardboard

You have an artwork already wrapped in paper. Now you need to add the **Corrugated Cardboard** layer.

Cut the cardboard:

- in straight lines.
- long enough for the artwork.



Use the table

Put the piece of cardboard on the table.

Put the artwork wrapped in paper on top of the cardboard.



Wrap in the cardboard

Roll or wrap the artwork in the cardboard.

- Make sure the corrugations in the cardboard go along the art work, like in the photo - **horizontal**.



Wrap

Keep wrapping the artwork until it is covered in the cardboard.



Tape

Tape the cardboard join in the middle to hold it closed.



Tape

Tape the cardboard joins up near the ends.

- Add tape to the join all the way along to keep it strong.



Both ends

To cover both ends:

- Cut the cardboard in three places down to near the artwork.



Fold cardboard

Push the cardboard in to cover the end of the artwork.

Hold the cardboard in place with your hands.



Tape over ends

Cover the end with tape to hold it closed.



Tape both ends

Place another piece of tape across the end.

- Press the tape down to hold in place.

Do these steps again at the other end.
